



Mr. M. Alex Baird is the Chief of Family Programs, National Guard Bureau (NGB). As Chief of Family Programs, Mr. Baird is the resident expert on family issues and program needs. His role includes, but is not limited to, developing and maintaining contact and liaison with multiple government agencies and civilian organizations that interact with the National Guard on family and quality-of-life issues. Mr. Baird also develops and delivers presentations and training to military and civilian audiences on family and life issues and programs throughout the National Guard. He managed the process for establishing and maintaining the Military Health System Strategic Plan, and the Department of Defense and Department of Veterans Affairs Joint Strategic Plan. Additionally, Mr. Baird was responsible for programs in support of Department of Defense and Department of Veterans Affairs joint collaboration and resource sharing to include the development of the initial charters for the Department of Defense and Department of Veterans Affairs Joint Executive Council and Benefits Executive Council.
