

Meet the Secretariat's Campaign Managers, CDR Karen Follin and Robert Jackson



CDR Follin joined the Department of the Navy Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Office (SAPR) in 2014 as the Health and Community Integration Liaison Officer. CDR enlisted in 1984 and served as a Hospital Corpsman prior to receiving her commission in 1993. Prior to being deployed to Afghanistan as the Trauma Coordinator, she worked at Navy Medical Center Portsmouth, White House Medical Unit with President George W. Bush, and Ship's Nurse onboard USS John F. Kennedy during Operation Iraqi Freedom.



Robert joined the Department of the Navy SAPR Office in January 2012 after three years with the Office of the Naval Inspector General. He is responsible for conducting high priority special assignments that are unprecedented and complex regarding state of the art prevention strategies. Robert is a retired Navy Supply Corps Captain. Prior to the Navy, he served as an Army rifleman before being commissioned an infantry officer. He later qualified as a special forces officer serving in Southeast Asia.


