Tier 1b (all qualifying personnel have equal priority)

Critical National Capabilities

Personnel forward deployed to austere environments

Personnel preparing to deploy to locations outside the United States

Authorized persons aged ≥ 75 years

Frontline essential workers

Phase 1c (all qualifying personnel have equal priority)

Persons aged ≥ 65-74 years

Persons aged ≥ 16-64 with increased risk for severe illness as defined by CDC Personnel

Persons deployed/TDY for more than 30 days outside of the U.S.

Essential workers not previously included in Tiers 1a or 1b

Tier 2

Persons aged ≥ 16 years not previously identified for vaccination

18 years of age
